Appendix A: Understanding Changes Over Time

The *Global Rule of Law and Business Dashboard 2026* report summarizes key methodological updates between the 5th and 6th editions and their implications for country scores. This Appendix provides a more detailed technical overview of these changes. It also presents a structured approach to comparing results over time by isolating methodology-driven changes from real-world trends, supported by reconstructed 2021 scores and detailed country-level comparisons.

Update to Previous Methodology

The 2026 Dashboard represents a methodological update to prior editions. Namely, prior editions of the Dashboard:

- Included a set of measures drawn from seven established indices and surveys.
- Calculated a single overall score by averaging variables within individual data sources to calculate a data source score, and then averaging the seven data source scores.

The implications of this methodology were that previous editions:

- Were not able to calculate scores for the individual pillars of the rule of law for business, but rather only the overall Dashboard score.
- Treated missing data in a way that implied the weighting of rule of law pillars in the final Dashboard score could change from country to country. For example, if a country was not included in Transparency International's Global Corruption Barometer, the final Dashboard score for that country would have underweighted Pillar 4 (Accountability), relative to the Dashboard scores of other countries.

The main methodological update in the 2026 version of the Dashboard is that variables are

first mapped to indicators, each of which in turn maps to one of the five pillars of the rule of law for business. Weights are assigned by pillar and indicator. This ensures that even when a country has missing data for a given variable or data source, the weighting of different conceptual aspects of the rule of law is consistent from country to country.

A second methodological update relates to the selection of data sources. Several data sources used in previous editions of the Dashboard have since been discontinued, restructured, or published less regularly. To address this in the 2026 Dashboard, NORC conducted a comprehensive review of potential data sources, and used a clear set of inclusion criteria to select a final group of 12 high-quality global data sources for inclusion. As part of the inclusion criteria, only primary data sources were selected to ensure no underlying data source was double counted (e.g., secondary data sources may have drawn from the same primary sources, which would have resulted in those sources being counted multiple times). This process resulted in an expanded set of over 100 variables that are now included in the calculation of Dashboard scores.

Conceptual and Weighting Changes

The changes described above imply that the weighting of individual pillars and indicators has changed between the previous and current editions of the Dashboard. This is important because any attempt to compare scores from prior editions to the current edition would conflate methodological changes with actual performance changes, making direct comparisons inappropriate.

As mentioned, previous editions of the Dashboard did not explicitly map variables to

pillars or indicators, as done in the 2026 Dashboard. As such, users may reasonably ask whether the concepts described by the pillars and indicators in the updated methodology are all reflected in prior editions of the Dashboard. NORC retrospectively mapped variables from the 2021 Dashboard to the new pillar and indicator framework. This exercise confirmed that all concepts introduced in the 2026 Dashboard were covered in some form in the old index.

However, it is clear that the weighting each pillar and indicator receives is very different between the prior and current editions. We cannot definitively calculate the weighting of individual pillars or indicators in legacy editions of the Dashboard because the weight of the data sources varied by country depending on data availability, and because one of the sources (World Bank Worldwide Governance Indicators) cannot be disaggregated to estimate the conceptual weight of underlying variables given a complex, multi-source weighting structure.

Yet it is also clear that indicators such as Indicator 1.2 (Business Information Ecosystem), Indicator 4.2 (Institutional Integrity and Open Government), and Indicator 5.2 (Fair and Impartial Proceedings) were minimally represented in the old Dashboard, given the very few variables that mapped to these indicators and the number of other variables included from the corresponding data sources. Further, for reasons described previously regarding the treatment of missing data, the relative weight of different pillars and indicators even varied from country to country within the 2021 Dashboard.

Measuring Changes Over Time

Due to the methodological changes, scores from the 2021 and 2026 editions of the Dashboard should not be used to examine changes in the

rule of law conditions for business over time. The updates in the current edition make it impossible to isolate changes due to trends from changes due to methodology. To facilitate comparisons over time, NORC compiled data for 2021 from the data sources included in the updated 2026 methodology, and used the updated methodology to retrospectively calculate 2021 scores using the updated conceptual and measurement framework.

Table 1 shows the Dashboard scores and country rankings for 2021 using the legacy and current methodologies, and for 2026 using the current methodology. Since each calculation includes a slightly different number of countries, country rankings are shown as percentiles to permit more direct comparisons. Comparing the 2021 results from the previous methodology to the 2021 results from the new methodology helps to show the changes in scores due to updated methods. For example, Algeria's score for 2021 dropped by approximately 15 points using the new methodology, although its percentile rank compared to other countries was mostly unchanged, with a score that was higher than only approximately 11 percent of countries. On the other hand, Argentina's score was mostly unchanged but its percentile rank improved by approximately 26 percentage points. These patterns highlight how the scores across methodologies are not directly comparable and may have led to important changes in the relative rank of some countries.

Comparing 2021 results with the updated methodology to 2026 results helps to examine the changes due to trends over time. Differences in the overall score reflect actual changes in rule of law performance over time, while differences in the percentile rank reflect changes in a country's ranked position relative to other countries.

Patterns in Score Changes Over Time

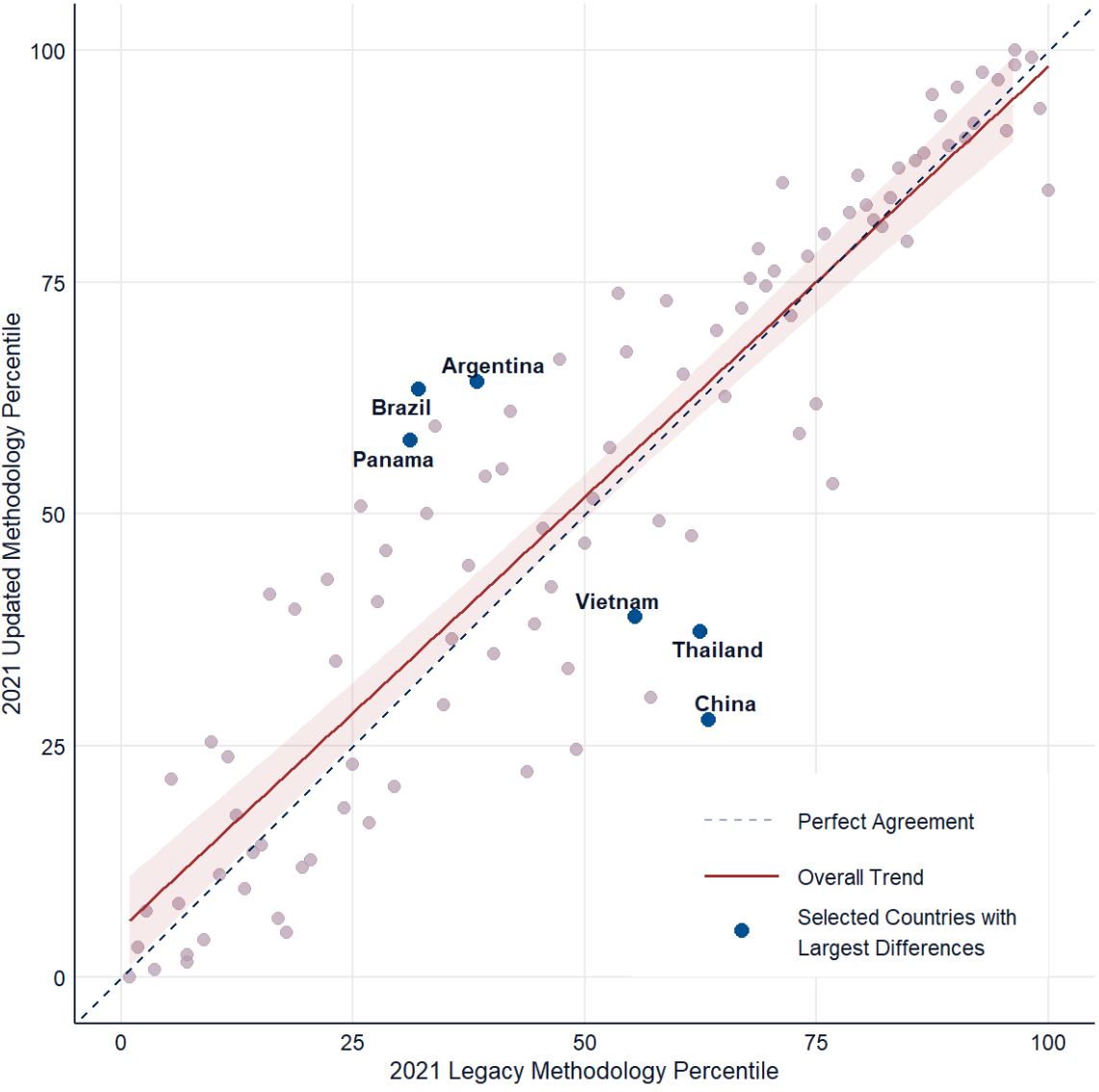
Understanding changes in Dashboard scores requires distinguishing between methodological updates and real-world developments. The analysis below presents two complementary comparisons: one that isolates the impact of the updated framework itself, and another that captures genuine changes in rule of law conditions for business over time using a consistent methodology.

Methodology-Driven Changes. Figure 1 plots country overall Dashboard scores resulting from the 2021 legacy methodology (published in the 5th edition of the Dashboard) against the 2021 scores with the updated methodology. Since they use different methodologies but are measured for the same year, this comparison of scores isolates changes due to shifts in the methodological framework. For the 99 countries that have data that allow us to calculate 2021 scores for both methodologies, the correlation coefficient between the two scores is 0.91.

While this indicates a strong correlation, it is important to note that 39 countries see a change of 10 percentage points or more in their ranked

percentile from one methodology to the other. There are also important regional patterns in how countries' scores change. In particular, 16 of the 22 countries that see improvements of 10 percentage points or more in their ranked percentile with the new methodology are in Latin America and the Caribbean; 8 of the 16 countries that decline by 10 percentage points or more with the new methodology are in Asia. One driver of these regional trends appears to be the inclusion of Indicator 4.2 (Institutional Integrity and Open Government) in the updated methodology, which includes variables measuring transparency in the government budget and public procurement, right to information laws, and openness of the policymaking process. These aspects were minimally represented in the legacy methodology. Most countries in Latin America have scores on this indicator that are notably higher than their overall Dashboard score, implying that the inclusion of Indicator 4.2 in the updated methodology increases the score for these countries. On the other hand, a number of Asian countries, including Singapore, China, Cambodia, and Malaysia, score notably lower on Indicator 4.2 than their overall Dashboard score, implying its inclusion is driving their scores down.

Comparable Trends Over Time. Figure 2 plots country scores for 2021 and 2026, both calculated using the updated methodology. By using the same measurement framework, this comparison of scores should isolate changes due to shifts in the underlying conditions in each country. For the 112 countries that have data that allow us to calculate scores for both years, the correlation coefficient between the two scores is 0.98, which indicates substantial stability in relative country rankings while still allowing for meaningful identification of countries that have experienced significant improvements or declines.

Comparing the 2021 and 2026 results from the updated methodology, just 12 percent of countries see a change of 10 percentage points or more in their percentile ranking. Where these large changes are seen, there are no major regional trends or shifts. This suggests large changes during the period were relatively isolated at the level of individual countries.

Countries experiencing some of the largest declines between 2021 and 2026 include Tunisia, Russia, Trinidad and Tobago, Ethiopia, Ecuador, and Burkina Faso. These can be explained by recent events. For example, declines in Ecuador are largely driven by Pillar 3 (Stability), which can be explained by increasing drug-related violence leading to deteriorating security conditions since 2021¹. In Tunisia, declines are more widespread, driven by large declines in Pillars 2 (Predictability), 4 (Accountability), and 5 (Due Process), and are explained by the country's recent consolidation of power under the

President, a weakened legislature and judiciary, new constitution, and political repression.²

On the other hand, countries experiencing some of the largest improvements between 2021 and 2026 include Nepal, Saudi Arabia, Tanzania, and Angola. In Saudi Arabia, the changes are driven almost entirely by a large improvement in its Pillar 2 (Predictability) score, which may reflect legal reforms, such as the 2023 Civil Transactions Law, the country's first comprehensive civil code that codifies Sharia law principles covering contracts, property rights, financial transactions, and dispute resolution. Previously, Saudi law had been based primarily on uncodified principles from Islamic text that did not rely on judicial precedent, making outcomes difficult to predict.³ While Saudi Arabia also saw more modest improvements in Pillar 5 (Due Process), likely stemming from these same reforms, little to no change is seen for other pillars.

For countries experiencing large shifts in Dashboard scores between 2021 and 2026, these examples demonstrate that the trends reflect genuine changes in rule of law conditions on the ground, validated by documented legal reforms, political developments, and security events that affect business operating environments.

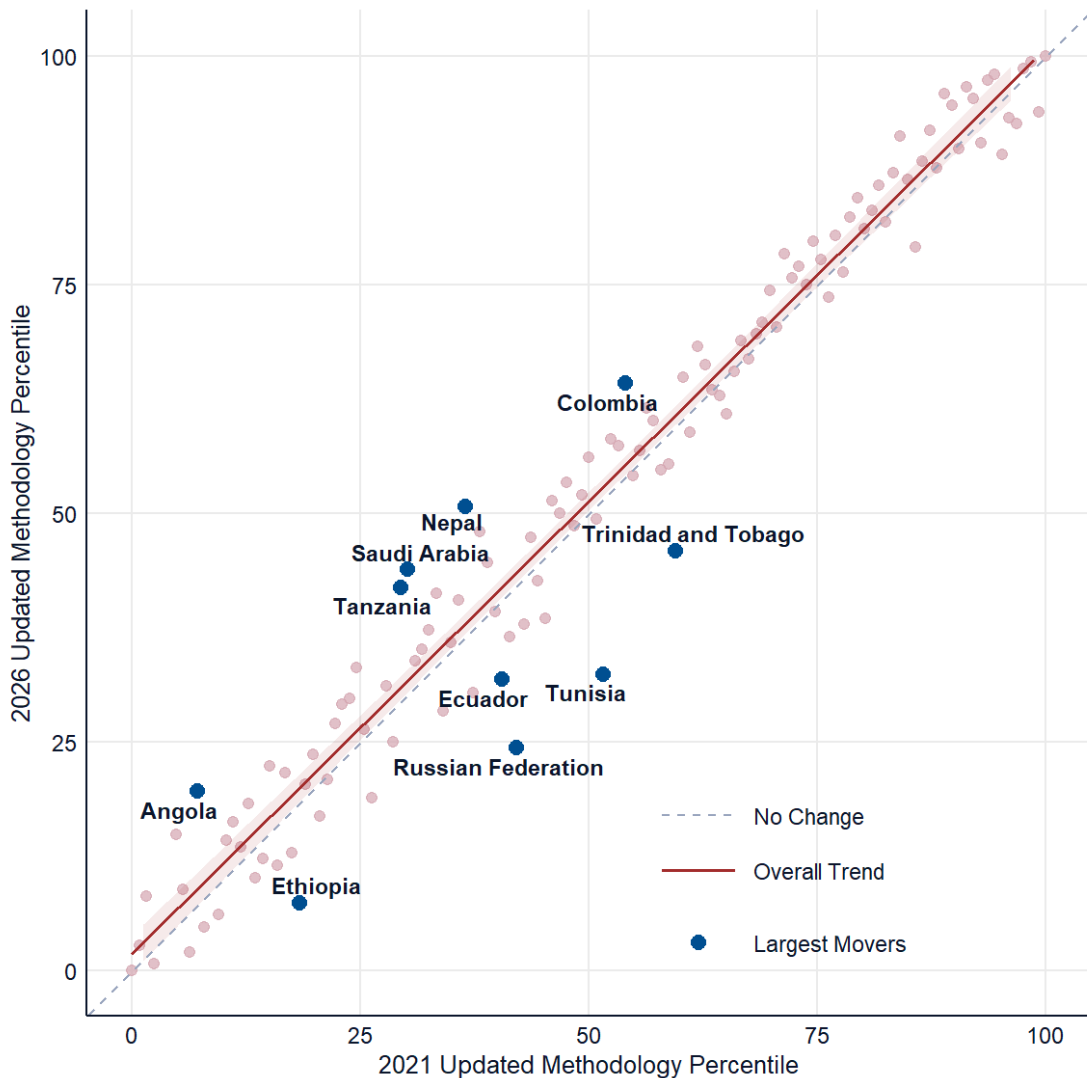

Appendix B: GDP and Dashboard Scores

The *Global Rule of Law and Business Dashboard 2026* report explores the relationship between rule of law and economic development in its Data Insights chapter, highlighting the association between GDP per capita and scores for Pillar 2 (Predictability) and Pillar 5 (Due Process). These findings underscore the close connection between stronger rule of law conditions and improved economic outcomes, particularly in areas that support regulatory consistency and fair adjudication.

This appendix extends this analysis by presenting these relationships at both the overall level and across all five pillars, providing a more comprehensive view of how different dimensions of the rule of law relate to economic development. By examining each pillar individually, the annex offers additional insight into how different aspects of the rule of law are associated with economic performance across countries.

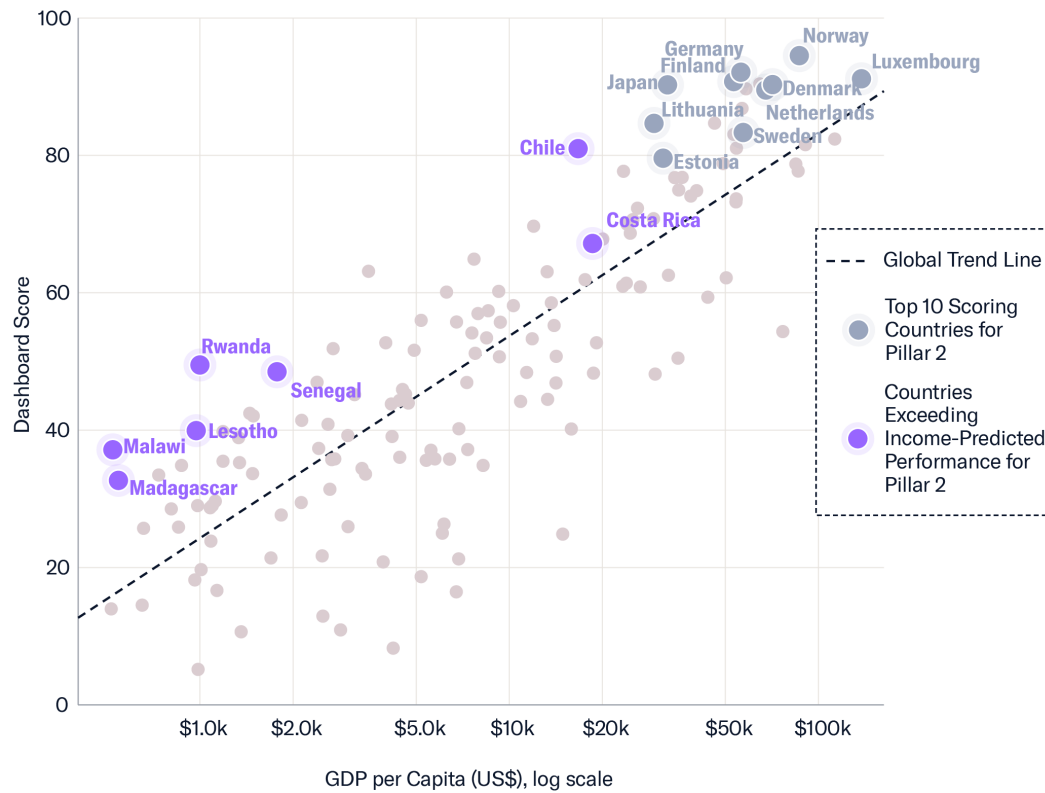


Figure 6. GDP and Pillar 3: Stability
