ORDER

Upon consideration of the petition for writ of mandamus, the emergency motion for stay pending petition for writ of mandamus, the amicus brief of the Chamber of Commerce of the United States of America, and Jones Day's motion to participate as amicus curiae and to exceed the word limit and the lodged brief; the combined response thereto; and the reply, it is

ORDERED that the motion to participate as amicus curiae and to exceed the word limit be granted. The Clerk is directed to file the lodged amicus brief. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the petition for writ of mandamus be denied. Petitioner has not shown that it has a "clear and indisputable right" to the relief requested. See Gulfstream Aerospace Corp. v. Mayacamas Corp., 485 U.S. 271, 289 (1988). It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the administrative stay, entered March 16, 2020, be dissolved. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the emergency motion for stay be dismissed as moot.
