Upon consideration of the petition for writ of mandamus, the court grants the petition and directs the district court to vacate those portions of its November 9, 2019; December 20, 2019; and February 26, 2020 orders that require Fluor to disclose privileged information from the investigation relating to the subject matter of the four statements at issue. The court denies the petition's request that the case be reassigned on remand. A more fulsome opinion will follow this order that includes the court's rationale.

Upon consideration of submissions relative to the motion for leave to file a brief as *amici curiae* in support of petitioners' request for a writ of mandamus, the

court denies the motion.
