Department Description:

Position Overview:

The South Asia team intern will primarily work on membership services, event coordination, and communications, but will have exposure to all areas of the South Asia team.

Job Responsibilities:

- Support event logistics by creating meeting flyers, organizing attendee lists; and creating online registration websites, as well as official readouts for members.
- Research and analyze developments in India's economic policy and assist in the preparation of background briefs, sector updates, press releases, and official correspondence
- Track relevant U.S. and Indian legislation, calls for comments, and position papers of interest to member-companies
- Research the activities of current and potential member-companies and foundations
- Participate in relevant government and company meetings, as appropriate

Qualifications:

Enrolled in the final year of an undergraduate degree or graduate program and available 15 hours per week; strong writing skills; interest in trade and investment policy, political economy, public policy, and/or government affairs; interest in U.S.-India and U.S.-Bangladesh commercial relations, previous South Asia knowledge and/or experience is helpful but not required; proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite, and team-player willing to pitch in for “all hands on deck” events.

This will be a hybrid internship and will be conducted in-person in our Washington D.C. offices and remotely. Applicants may select either monetary compensation or academic credit.
