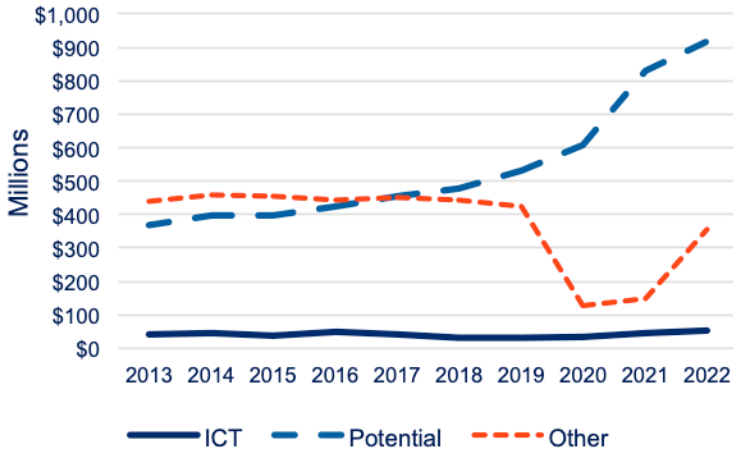




# Florida's 22nd and Digital Trade

FL-22 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$43 million in 2013 to \$54 million in 2022 (25%), supporting 124 direct and 105 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$368 million to \$919 million (150%), supporting 3,228 direct and 2,394 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services declined from \$439 million in 2013 to \$426 million in 2019 (-3%), and then fell sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

**Florida's 22nd district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 3,352 direct and 2,500 indirect American jobs in 2022.**

Europe was Florida's 22nd district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Central & South America.

Florida's 22nd district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Switzerland grew from \$21 million in 2013 to \$70 million (+236%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$330 million out of Florida's 22nd district's \$973 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$8.6 million in 2013 to \$27 million in 2022 (217%).

Business management and consulting services are Florida's 22nd district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$110 million in 2013 to \$347 million in 2022 (217%).
