
Missouri's 3rd and Digital Trade

MO-3 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$103 million in 2013 to \$205 million in 2022 (99%), supporting 372 direct and 560 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$403 million to \$555 million (38%), supporting 1,570 direct and 969 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$405 million in 2013 to \$442 million in 2019 (9%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Missouri's 3rd district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,942 direct and 1,529 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Missouri's 3rd district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Missouri's 3rd district's exports of ICT services to Canada grew from \$10 million in 2013 to \$24 million (+134%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$324 million out of Missouri's 3rd district's \$760 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Miscellaneous computer services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$57 million in 2013 to \$83 million in 2022 (47%).

Credit-related services are Missouri's 3rd district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, but fell from \$181 million in 2013 to \$179 million in 2022 (-1%).
