
## New York's 7th and Digital Trade

NY-7 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$1.8 million in 2013 to \$27 million in 2022 (1436%), supporting 44 direct and 38 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$329 million to \$494 million (50%), supporting 1,359 direct and 832 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$441 million in 2013 to \$629 million in 2019 (43%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

New York's 7th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,403 direct and 870 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was New York's 7th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

New York's 7th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to United Kingdom grew from \$48 million in 2013 to \$91 million (+89%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$234 million out of New York's 7th district's \$521 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Royalties from computer software are the top ICT services export, growing from \$294,000 in 2013 to \$23 million in 2022 (7,825%).

Miscellaneous financial services are New York's 7th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$114 million in 2013 to \$138 million in 2022 (21%).
