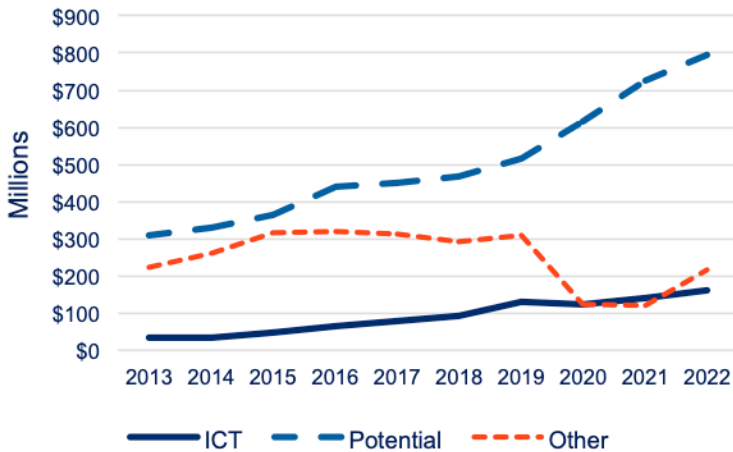




# Texas' 26th and Digital Trade

TX-26 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports grew from \$33 million in 2013 to \$160 million in 2022 (382%), supporting 481 direct and 371 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$308 million to \$796 million (158%), supporting 2,525 direct and 1,747 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$223 million in 2013 to \$311 million in 2019 (39%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

**Texas' 26th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 3,006 direct and 2,118 indirect American jobs in 2022.**

Europe was Texas' 26th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Texas' 26th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Canada grew from \$22 million in 2013 to \$48 million (+119%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$326 million out of Texas' 26th district's \$956 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$21 million in 2013 to \$133 million in 2022 (528%).

Business management and consulting services are Texas' 26th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$96 million in 2013 to \$309 million in 2022 (221%).
