
## Wisconsin's 4th and Digital Trade

WI-4 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports fell from \$130 million in 2013 to \$120 million in 2022 (-8%), but still supported 187 direct and 304 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$486 million to \$584 million (20%), supporting 1,505 direct and 1,254 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$366 million in 2013 to \$438 million in 2019 (20%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Wisconsin's 4th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,692 direct and 1,558 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Wisconsin's 4th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Wisconsin's 4th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Ireland grew from \$29 million in 2013 to \$52 million (+77%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$294 million out of Wisconsin's 4th district's \$704 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Miscellaneous computer services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$38 million in 2013 to \$46 million in 2022 (22%).

Insurance services are Wisconsin's 4th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$91 million in 2013 to \$136 million in 2022 (50%).
