
Wisconsin's 8th and Digital Trade

WI-8 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports were mostly flat around \$22 million from 2013 to 2022, supporting 55 direct and 40 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$277 million to \$445 million (61%), supporting 1,220 direct and 806 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services grew from \$257 million in 2013 to \$299 million in 2019 (16%), before falling sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

Wisconsin's 8th district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 1,274 direct and 846 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was Wisconsin's 8th district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

Wisconsin's 8th district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Switzerland grew from \$20 million in 2013 to \$38 million (+93%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$209 million out of Wisconsin's 8th district's \$467 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$3.7 million in 2013 to \$13 million in 2022 (262%).

Insurance services are Wisconsin's 8th district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, growing from \$105 million in 2013 to \$149 million in 2022 (43%).
