
West Virginia's 1st and Digital Trade

WV-1 Services Exports, 2013-2022



ICT services exports fell from \$4.6 million in 2013 to \$3.5 million in 2022 (-24%), but still supported 7 direct and 7 indirect jobs in 2022.

Potentially ICT-enabled services exports grew from \$189 million to \$202 million (7%), supporting 631 direct and 431 indirect jobs in 2022.

Exports of other services declined from \$478 million in 2013 to \$440 million in 2019 (-8%), and then fell sharply due to Covid-19. They have not yet fully recovered.

West Virginia's 1st district's digitally tradeable services exports supported 639 direct and 438 indirect American jobs in 2022.

Europe was West Virginia's 1st district's top market for digitally tradeable services, followed by Asia & Pacific (ex. China).

West Virginia's 1st district's exports of potentially ICT-enabled services to Ireland grew from \$12 million in 2013 to \$23 million (+93%) in 2022.

The "Digital Dozen" accounted for \$83 million out of West Virginia's 1st district's \$206 million in exports of digitally tradeable services in 2022.

Computer software services are the top ICT services export, growing from \$344,000 in 2013 to \$1.6 million in 2022 (365%).

Royalties from industrial processes are West Virginia's 1st district's top potentially ICT-enabled services export, but fell from \$58 million in 2013 to \$40 million in 2022 (-31%).
