**NOTICE OF LODGING  
PROPOSED CONSENT DECREE**

1 Defendants United States Environmental Protection Agency, Lisa P. Jackson,  
2 in her official capacity as Administrator of the United States Environmental  
3 Protection Agency, and Jared Blumenfeld, in his official capacity as Regional  
4 Administrator for Region IX of the United States Protection Agency (collectively,  
5 “EPA”), hereby lodge with the Court a proposed consent decree that contains the  
6 terms of a proposed settlement of this action. *See* Attachment 1, Consent Decree.

7 **The proposed consent decree should not be signed or entered by the**  
8 **Court at this time.** Pursuant to section 113(g) of the Clean Air Act, 42 U.S.C. §  
9 7413(g), the EPA Administrator must provide “a reasonable opportunity by notice  
10 in the Federal Register to persons who are not named as parties or intervenors to the  
11 action or matter to comment in writing” upon the proposed consent decree.  
12 Accordingly, EPA will publish in the Federal Register a notice of the proposed  
13 consent decree and request comments. After a reasonable comment period, the  
14 EPA Administrator will promptly consider any written comments received and, if  
15 none of the comments disclose facts or considerations which indicate that the  
16 proposed consent decree is inappropriate, improper, inadequate, or inconsistent  
17 with the requirements of the Clean Air Act, Defendants will move for entry of the  
18 decree.
